



Topaz Stone



The nature of the light of the sign of Aries was imparted to the Old Testament tribe of Issachar, which was identified in the Breastplate of the High Priest by a topaz stone. Jacob's prophesy concerning his son Issachar enlightens us further as to the reward or blessing which came to this tribe from the Creative Word and Light shining forth from Aries. "Issachar is a strong ass couching down between two burdens: And he saw that rest was good, and the land that it was pleasant; and bowed his shoulder to bear, and became a

servant unto tribute (Genesis 49:14,15)." "Issachar is a strong ass couch-

ing down between two burdens:..." This is a strange Scripture and difficult to understand unless we associate it with the Principles found in the zodiac. From the context of these two verses, we see that Issachar saw that rest was good; therefore, he went to work to secure the land for his habitation. His tribe were people who were attached to the land. Jacob prophesied that Issachar and his tribe would be strong and industrious with a love to labour particularly in the toil of husbandry.

Tribe of Benjamin

Amethyst Stone



The nature of the light of the sign of Taurus was imparted to the Old Testament tribe of Benjamin, which was associated with the amethyst stone. As the light of Taurus, the Bull, shone down on Benjamin, it give him a twofold nature—the nature of the Warrior-Bull and the nature of the Husbandman-Bull. This is seen in the two names given to Benjamin at his birth. Rachel, the beloved wife of Jacob, travailed in hard labour to bein this, her last son, to birth. As she was dying, she named the child *Ben-oni* which means the son of my sorrow. But, Jacob called his son Benjamin which means the son of the right hand.

"And they journeyed from Beth-el: and there was but a little way to come to Ephrath: and Rachel travailed, and she had hard labour. And it came to pass, when she was in the hard labour. That the midwife said unto her, Fear not, thou shalt have this son, also. And it cam to pass, as her soul was in departing, (for she died) that she called his name Ben-oni: but his father called him Benjamin (Genesis 35:16-18). These two names reveal the twofold nature of this tribe. The Suffering Humility side is represented by the name of Ben-oni, whereas the Exalted Glory side is represented by the name of Benjamin. Ben-oni, the son of suffering, meant travail and death because Rachel had to lay down her own life to give birth to this son.

Gad—Meaning troop, those belonging to the tribe of Gad pray for the final victory over the enemy, as the tribes work with Christ to overcome (Genesis 49:19; Deuteronomy 33:20).

Dan – Meaning to judge, those belonging to the tribe of Dan help to maintain balance and equilibrium by weighing the scales of God's justice and judgment through wisdom, courage, and strength that comes from the Word and praying for others (Genesis 49:16-17; Deuteronomy 33:22).



Asher—Meaning happy and blessed, those belonging to the tribe of Asher share the abundance that the LORD has blessed them with and are willing to serve (Genesis 49:20; Deuteronomy 33:24-25).



Naphtali – Meaning to wrestle or fight, those belonging to the tribe of Naphtali are prevailing ones, who will continue to pray when others give up (Genesis 49:21; Deuteronomy 33:23).



Benjamin—Meaning son of the right hand, those belonging to the tribe of Benjamin display the twofold nature of the LORD—humility and exaltation—as they pray for Christ's second coming (Genesis 49: 27; Deuteronomy 33:12).



Joseph—Ephraim—Meaning fruitfulness, those belonging to the tribe of Ephraim depict blessing and fruitfulness that God desires to give in the natural and the spiritual, as they recognize and care for the concerns of those in need (Genesis 49:22-25; Deuteronomy . 33-13-17).

Joseph—Manasseh—Meaning to forget, those belonging to the tribe of Manasseh pray for others to forgive and forget through humility (Genesis 49:22-26; Deuteronomy 33:13-17).

Levi—Meaning to be joined to, those belonging to the tribe of Levi join in prayer for those who have a hard time being faithful to what God is doing in all the tribes (Genesis 49:5-7; Deuteronomy 33:8-11).

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Sermon Study # 3434 FOUR CLASSES OF WITNESSES GOD USED ON RESURRECTION DAY — (SUN AM 4/05/2015) (Resurrection Day) We see the Unbegotten LORD's Tetragrammaton, His Holy Name revealed, again, in the Resurrection Story. In the first Corner of the LORD's foursquare Name is the *yod* of His Omnipresent Wisdom-Love; in the second Corner of the LORD's foursquare Name is the first hay of His Omnipotent Understanding-Love; in the third Corner of the LORD's foursquare Name is the vaw of His Omniscient Knowledge-Love; in the fourth corner of the LORD's foursquare Name is the second hay of the Prudence-Love of His Purposive Will The bible tells us that God sent the Angel Gabriel to Zacharias with the promise of a son, whom he was to name John. This man would be John the Baptist, who was to be the forerunner of Jesus Christ. Then, the Angel Gabriel was sent to the Virgin Mary with the Promise of her being the Messiah's mother; next, the Angel Gabriel was sent to Joseph, Mary's husband, to establish the Virgin Birth of the Christ Child. Last, the Angel Gabriel was sent to the tomb at Jesus' Death, and he rolled the stone away and told the women, "Come see the place where the Lord lay." When Jesus hung on the Cross, at the sixth hour, the veil of the Temple was rent in the midst, and the Humility Glory shone out upon Jesus' Heart, Arm, and Hands. Then, at the ninth hour, the veil of the Temple was rent from top to bottom, and the Exalted Glory shone out upon Jesus' Body from His Head to His Feet. A witness of these Glories was left in the tomb from Jesus' Resurrection as First-fruits for us to experience as we go to the tomb by faith. There were four classes of creatures who witnessed to those coming to the tomb on Resurrection Day; the Angel Gabriel (Matthew 28:2-6), a young man (Mark 16:3-7), two mortal men (Luke 24:1-6) and two Angels—one at the Head and one at the Foot of where Jesus had lain (John 20:11,12). Sermon Study # 3408 I AM THE RESURRECTION AND THE LIFE — (SUN AM 11/2/2014) Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today (now), and forever (tomorrow). By doing a comparative analysis of our spiritual dispensation *yesterday* and *now*, we will understand more about how to fight our battles. On one side of the scales, there was yesteryear, when we, as a church, had a litte Stature or Word, and the Holy Ghost was powerful and ministering close to Earth, and there was less opposition and fewer devils to fight. On the other side of the scales, now, we have a big Stature or Word, but the Holy Ghost has moved away above the Earth, and now, there are more devils and more opposition. We must learn to discern the difference that our large Stature of the Word empowers us, now, to fight this increase of devils and opposition. In John, the eleventh chapter, we find the account of the death of Lazarus, one of Jesus' dear friends. Jesus deliberately waited until Lazarus was dead before answering Mary and Martha's message to come to their home in order to heal their brother Lazarus. During this occasion, Jesus suffered four attacks against Himself as "I am the Resurrection and the Life." The first attack came from Martha, Lazarus' sister, who scorned Him for not being there before Lazarus dies, then Lazarus' sister Mary who scorned Him for not being there. Next, some Jewish friends scorned Jesus, and then, again Martha scorned Hism when He asked for the stone to be rolled away from the tomb. Jesus tried to minister to his beloved friends first from where He was when He said, "I am the resurrection and the life, then when that did not work, He came down below them and ministered to them where they were, exchanged places with them, groaned and wept. . We must learn to not get angry with people if, at first, we cannot reach them from our personal spiritual level, but, as Jesus did, come below, exchange places and weep with them. When we feel the spirit of our day of death and darkness pulling us down, we must scream as loud as we can, "Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life!" In our most desperate situation, we must believe that Jesus is still the Resurrection and the Life. Pg. 3.



Behemoth — Spirit of Laziness and Attacking Others. At times the behemoth is shamefully lazy and secretly hides itself. Other times, it dishonorably attacks others. By accusing and criticizing others with a harsh, harmful, and hard spirit, and, yet, sometimes being withdrawn and lazy, the behemoth displays the same duality in its nature that the hippopotamus does.

For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil (I John 3:8). Christ's temptation, sufferings, and His ignominious Death, plus the fierce oppositions and persecutions that His followers have endured, are significantly described in the Scriptures as the bruising of the heel (the crucified heel) of the Seed of the woman. The complete victory that our Redeemer, Christ Jesus, has Himself achieved over sin and Death, and that His Grace enables the believer also to obtain, has been accomplished by the crushing and the bruising of the old Serpent's head. Ultimately, believers gain still more triumph by growth in the Spiritual Stature of Christ Jesus, as they experience the Truth of God's Word.
