"The Rapture"

What is the "Rapture"? Will every Christian believer be in the Rapture? How does a person prepare for the Rapture? When will this event take place? What will be the results of this phenomenal happening? What follows the Rapture on God's Calendar of Events? These are questions that people need answers to today! God's Clock marks the hours allotted to man in the measured amount of space which God calls time, and the hands on His Clock are pointing to the last hour man has left. Sometime during this hour, the time of the Rapture will take place. It could happen anytime! God's Holy Word is not only a revelation of His Son, Jesus, but it is also a prophetic message to man so that each person might be prepared in his heart for everything that will happen, from meeting his Creator at death, to being prepared for Jesus' soon Coming in the clouds, personally, for those who are ready. Although the word "Rapture" does not appear in the Bible, the Scriptures refer to the time of the LORD Jesus Christ's Coming in the air to catch away His Bride and the Wedding Party. It is this longawaited event that Christians everywhere refer to as the "Rapture." God's Word makes it abundantly clear that this event will take place: For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord (I Thessalonians 4:16,17). Since the Bible says that the LORD is coming back, it is appar- ent that He went away. After His Resurrection, He ascended into Heaven in His own personal Form. As He ascended, the Disciples stood watching Him. Jesus passed through the material Heavens up to the Throne of God where He assumed His position at the Right Hand of God the Father. He will remain seated there until He, personally, returns. The Angels told those who watched Him disappear into the clouds that He would return in like manner. And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight. And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel; Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven (Acts 1:9-11). In other words, Jesus Christ will reappear in the clouds. He will personally descend through the Heavens with the same Resurrection Glory with which He ascended. There will be one significant difference, however. When He returns, He will share His Resurrection Glory with all who are watching and longing for His appearing. The Scripture says, "We shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye." The Resurrection Glory of the LORD Jesus Christ will reach out to those who are prepared and watching for His Coming and will change them. This will be the only time that men on the Earth will escape Death. All other people have to go through Death and the grave. Death will lose its power in more than one way on that day, for in Glory and Power the bodies of dead believers also will be raised to become new glorified houses for their spirits and souls. Resurrected Saints of God will stand up in their glorified bodies while their whole being — body, soul, and spirit — magnifies Jesus Christ Face to face! If a man had a thousand tongues, he could never sufficiently praise Jesus for the glorious hope of seeing Him Face to face. All of life's trials, heartaches, and persecutions will seem as nothing on that glorious day! Those who have believed on Him will see the One Who died for them on the cruel Cross and be able to thank Him for His great Love. Because He loved mankind, He was willing to be a Sacrifice for all of man's sins. The Scripture further states that Jesus Christ will descend from Heaven with the shout of triumph! His shout will resound with pomp and Power, for it will contain all the Authority of the mighty King and Conqueror over sin, Death, Hell, and the grave. Jesus died to redeem man fully: spirit, soul, and body. At the present time, the spirits and souls of believers are in the process of being redeemed. On the day of the Rapture, Jesus Christ will finish the work. He will redeem the body from Death, corruption, weakness, and dishonour, and raise it up in the likeness of His own glorious Body. No wonder Jesus will descend with a shout of triumph and victory. Death will have to obey the Voice of the Victor!

In the sky are the natural lights which bear the shape or outline of the signs of the zodiac. We see these with our natural eyes. However, we could understand little about the intrinsic nature of these signs if the LORD had not raised up people who, having grown up under the influence of a particular sign, reflected the characteristics of the Light which shined down on them from the Heaven. The nature of the signs of the zodiac is revealed through the names of the tribes which came out of the loins

of the patriarch Jacob or Israel, as he was called in his later years. The blessing of power of the sign is seen in the stones used to identify each of the tribes. Let us now study what God's Word teaches about the sign of Virgo and the

tribe of Asher. **I. Description of the Sign** God begins His prophetic wheel of light in the sky with Virgo, the Virgin in whose hand and arm are seen sheaves of wheat or corn. This sign corresponds with the summer season. The nature of this sign is revealed through the tribe of Asher. The blessings of the power of Virgo is reflected in the onyx stone. The stars of the constellation of Virgo are seen in the similitude of a woman. Virgo is said to be an equatorial constellation of thirty-nine visible stars, with Spica as the brightest star. When the sun passes through this sign, the harvest is ready for the

The nature of the light of the sign of Leo was imparted to the Old Testament tribe of Judah, whose name means praise. Naturally speaking, Jesus was a descendant of the tribe of Judah through King David. Let us note the prophecy spoken by Jacob concerning Judah. *Judah, thou art he whom thy brethren shall praise: thy hand shall be in the neck of thine ememies; thy father's children shall bow down before thee. Judah is a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, thou art gone up: he stooped down, he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up? (Genesis 49:8,9). God was praised for Judah's*

birth; He was praised by him and praised in him; therefore, it is fitting that his brethren should praise him and that he should be victorious and successful in war. Judah represents the roar of praise which shall burst forth out of the Holy City in the ever unfolding ages of Eternity. The praise of the Lion is divided in this prophecy in order to give us greater understanding of the realms of praise.

Reuben—Meaning "behold ye a son," as the firstborn those belonging to the tribe of Rueben will fight against fornication and will fight for divorce settlements (Genesis 49:3-4; Deuteronomy



Gad—Meaning troop, those belonging to the tribe of Gad pray for the final victory over the enemy, as the tribes work with Christ to overcome (Genesis 49:19; Deuteronomy 33:20).



Dan – Meaning to judge, those belonging to the tribe of Dan help to maintain balance and equilibrium by weighing the scales of God's justice and judgment through wisdom, courage, and strength that comes from the Word and praying for others (Genesis 49:16-17; Deuteronomy 33:22).

Asher—Meaning happy and blessed, those belonging to the tribe of Asher share the abundance that the LORD has blessed them with and are willing to serve (Genesis 49:20; Deuteronomy 33:24-25).





Sermon Study #3519 — JOB AND THE HORSE OF FAITH—1ST MESSGE — (SUN AM 2/14/2016) There is a great picture of Jesus Christ's Horse of Faith in Job, the thirty- ninth chapter, which relates to the Rapture of the saints in First Thessalonians 4:14-18. The first thing that God does in any experience is to establish His Headship. There are ten qualities that God gave Job that concern the Horse of Faith, and they fit with the Ten Commandments. His first quality was His gheb-oo-raw Strength, which fits with the First Commandment, "I am the LORD thy God." This is a very extraordinary day in Christ Gospel Churches. We are celebrating the Rapture of the Wedding Party and the Bride of Jesus Christ. Thank You, LORD. For years, I have talked to you concerning the Horse of Faith about which Job, chapter 39, tells us. That chapter is a description of the Rapture. The Bible says that Jesus is the Word of God, and Jesus said, "[I] am the light of the world..." (John 8:12). The Bible says "The entrance of thy words giveth light: it giveth understanding unto the simple" (Psalm 119:130). It says, "[I]n thy light shall we see light" (Psalm 36:9). Therefore, when Jesus gives us one great Cloud or Pillar of Light and we stand in that Light, we will see it give birth to more Light and on and on. There is no end to the Light in God's Word. His Word is Infinite and Divine because it comes from the Unbegotten Father. Let us turn to First Thessalonians 4:16 through 18 and read about the Rapture; then, we will go back to a lesson in Job, chapter 39. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words (I Thessalonians 4:16-18). How do we comfort one another? We do that by reminding one another that things will not always be as they are right now with so many powers of darkness rising up against Jesus Christ and His people who are being slaughtered around the world and back again. It will not always be as it is now. Just around the corner, Jesus will come again, and we are trying to get ready to get out of here. We are thanking the LORD. The Apostle Paul said, "For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel,..." (I Thessalonians 4:16). In Hebrew, the word that is used for Archangel is masculine plural, so there are more than one Archangel. Do you want me to tell you how many Archangels there are? There are seven Archangels. You may ask, "What is an Archangel? Let me tell you what an Archangel is. He is a helper who is under the Son of God who has a whole warring tribe of Angels that belong to him. Let us not be afraid of anyone who is against us because there are more for us than there are against us. There are seven Archangels, and they have tons of Angels under them. That is really something to shout about. The Apostle Paul said that he prayed that, "The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, " (Ephesians 1:18). It is so exciting to study God's Word. The Lord Himself is coming after us, and He shall descend from Heaven with the voice of Archangels of which there are seven. Speaking of the Angels, the Bible says, "Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?" (Hebrews 1:14). Just stop and think about this. In addition to our having the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost and Jesus Who is at God's Right Hand—all the Godhead—working for us, there are seven Archangels with all their Angels that surround us. It is no wonder that the Bible says, "[I]f God be for us, who can be against us [and survive]?" (Romans 8:31). The Apostle Paul said, "For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words" (I Thessalonians 4:16-18). It behooves us to be ready to leave planet Earth at any time. We will not take with us anything other than God's Word that we have allowed Jesus Christ to put in our heart for His Name's sake.




