## From the Pen of Reverend B. R. Hicks

### “ Growing in God “

What is more exciting than something that is growing? Growth is the visible manifestation of the increase of life, whether it be in the natural realm or in the spiritual realm. How heartbreaking, then, to see those who, for some reason, have been stunted in their natural growth or in their spiritual growth!

In his letter to the church at Ephesus, the Apostle Paul set forth the possibility of growth to full maturity in the Spiritual Stature of Christ, which every believer is called to press toward.

*And he gave some, apostles: and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: (Ephesians 4:11-13).*

The shadow and figure of the Stature of Jesus Christ is unveiled in the detailed blueprint of the Old Testament Tabernacle, know as Moses' Tabernacle. This was the first Tabernacle, and it was a picture of the Second Tabernacle, the LORD Jesus Christ: therefore, we can find all Spiritual Principles of Wisdom, Understanding, and Knowledge hidden within it. The Tabernacle of Moses was laid out in the form of the Cross, which was apparent in the positioning of its seven pieces of furniture. In the outer Court, or the beginning of the Cross, we find the Brazen Altar where the sacrifices were slain and where blood was shed, which is a picture of the shed Blood of Jesus Christ. Then, we see the Fire coming forth from God and lighting upon the sacrifices, which is a picture of the Baptism of the Holy Ghost and Fire. Also in the outer Court was the Brazen Laver where the Priest washed once, outwardly, which is a picture of Water Baptism in the Name, Death, and Life of Jesus Christ. The Priests returned to this Laver, daily, to wash their hands and feet, which is a picture of dying daily to the fleshly, carnal nature within us.

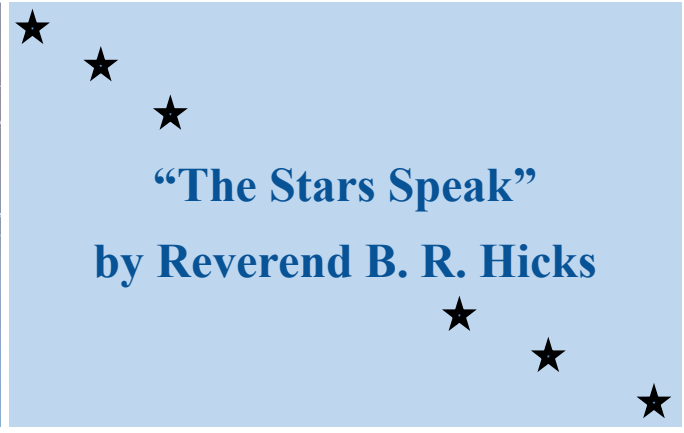

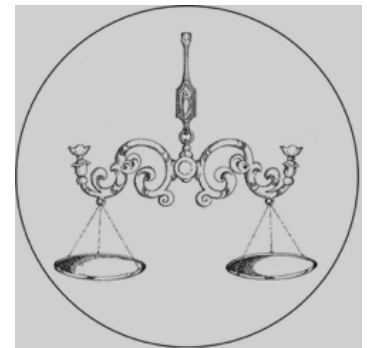

**Gad**—Meaning troop, those belonging to the tribe of Gad pray for the final victory over the enemy, as the tribes work with Christ to overcome (Genesis 49:19; Deuteronomy 33:20).



**Dan** – Meaning to judge, those belonging to the tribe of Dan help to maintain balance and equilibrium by weighing the scales of God’s justice and judgment through wisdom, courage, and strength that comes from the Word and praying for others (Genesis 49:16-17; Deuteronomy 33:22).



**Asher**—Meaning happy and blessed, those belonging to the tribe of Asher share the abundance that the LORD has blessed them with and are willing to serve (Genesis 49:20; Deuteronomy 33:24-25).



**Naphtali** – Meaning to wrestle or fight, those belonging to the tribe of Naphtali are prevailing ones, who will continue to pray when others give up (Genesis 49:21; Deuteronomy 33:23).



**Benjamin**—Meaning son of the right hand, those belonging to the tribe of Benjamin display the twofold nature of the LORD—humility and exaltation—as they pray for Christ’s second coming (Genesis 49: 27; Deuteronomy 33:12).



**Joseph—Ephraim**—Meaning fruitfulness, those belonging to the tribe of Ephraim depict blessing and fruitfulness that God desires to give in the natural and the spiritual, as they recognize and care for the concerns of those in need (Genesis 49:22-25; Deuteronomy . 33-13-17).



**Joseph—Manasseh**—Meaning to forget, those belonging to the tribe of Manasseh pray for others to forgive and forget through humility (Genesis 49:22-26; Deuteronomy 33:13-17).

**Levi**—Meaning to be joined to, those belonging to the tribe of Levi join in prayer for those who have a hard time being faithful to what God is doing in all the tribes (Genesis 49:5-7; Deuteronomy 33:8-11).

**Tape # 1492 Sermon Notes THE STRANGER PRINCIPLE — 1ST MESSAGE. (SUN AM 11/17/96)** The Stranger Principle relates to the Law of Circularity. The story of ten lepers who were cleansed by Jesus is recorded in Luke 17:11-19. Nine of the lepers were Jews; one was a Samaritan who was a stranger to the Commonwealth of Israel. As lepers, all ten men were standing afar off when they lifted up their voices, loudly asking Jesus to show them mercy. Jesus told all of them to go to Jerusalem and show themselves to the Priest, who, according to the Law, was the one who had to pronounce them clean. As they went on their way to Jerusalem, the Samaritan realized that he had been cleansed, and only he, a stranger, returned to express his gratitude to Jesus. Again, lifting up his voice, he glorified God and fell at the Feet of Jesus, giving Him thanks. To this stranger, Jesus said, “Arise, go thy way: thy faith hath made thee whole” (Luke 17:19). All ten men were cleansed of their leprosy, but only one — the Samaritan, the stranger — was made whole — body, soul, and spirit. Pg. 1 QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS. (SUN PM 11/17/96) The following two questions are answered in this lesson: Question #1: In Luke 22:28-30, Jesus said, “I appoint unto you a kingdom.” I want to know about “appointing you a kingdom.” Question #2: My question is in Genesis 17:17 and Genesis 18:12. I just wanted to know why the LORD said that Sarah laughed, but He never mentioned that Abraham laughed . . . . . Pg. 9

**Sermon Study # 2778—THE LORD’S GOVERNMENT PICTURED THROUGH THE NEW CITY OR HIS FOUR-SQUARE NAME. (SUN PM 3/29/2009)** This lesson begins by establishing the dimensions of the New City, which is four-square. The New City presents a picture of the LORD Jesus Christ, whose Name is foursquare. The letters of the Name LORD appear in each corner of His Name, which is comprised of the Hebrew letters yod, hay, vaw, hay. The yod of the LORD’s Name contains His Wisdom; the first hay contains His Understanding; the vaw contains His Knowledge; and the second hay contains His Prudence or Choice. As Christians, we are aware that we pass through spiritual seasons in our quest to grow in the LORD’s Name, which means Nature. The LORD’s Name and His Nature are synonymous. So as we move in our spiritual journey from season to season, we find that the yod or Wisdom of His Name relates to Summer; the first hay or Understanding to Winter; the vaw or Knowledge to Autumn; and the second hay or Prudence to Spring. The four letters of His Name also progress around the four cardinal points of the Cross—from the East, to the North, to the West, and to the South. The LORD’s Name makes up the foursquare New City. So that we can enter this City, God made openings on all four sides of it. These openings are Gates, and there are three Gates on each side of the City, which make 12 Gates. These Gates are Pearls and each Pearl is one of the 12 Governmental Names of the LORD, which are: LORD, God, Merciful, Gracious, Long-Suffering, Abundant in Goodness, Abundant in Truth, Preserver of Bountifulness, Forgiver of Iniquity, Forgiver of Transgression, Forgiver of Sins, and Just Judge. These Gates establish God’s pattern of 12 in the New City, which denotes God’s Government. Twelve Angels, who overcame Leviathan and the fallen Angels—Father Wicked, Mother Wickedness, Abaddon, and Lucifer, guard these Gates. Over these Gates are the names of the 12 Tribes of Israel. The Foundations to the New City contain the names of the 12 Apostles. Thus, through the 12 Gates, depicting Jesus Christ’s 12 Governmental Names, the 12 Tribes, and the 12 Angels, we have a threefold Witness of God’s Government. Then, adding the 12 Foundations under the walls gives us a complete Stature of God’s outward Government: 12 Gates; 12 Names of the LORD; 12 names of the Tribes; and the names of the 12 Apostles (Foundations). After dealing with the three Witnesses and the Stature of the twelve things that establish the LORD’s Governmental control of the New City, the lesson goes on to deal with God’s inner Government within the New City, which is shown through the 12 manner of Fruit that grows on each side of the Icy Street and the 12 manner of Fruit produced in the middle of the Icy Street. The Fruit on each side of the River grows in warm Water, representing the Son’s Will, and the Icy Fruit represents the Father’s Icy Will. In the New City, God’s Government exists solely and supremely— there is no other government. Ephesians 3:16-19 is dealt with briefly. The Bride’s scarlet Humility-Worm lips are mentioned, as in giving Jesus all the Glory, now, for all we have. Our spiritual education will continue in the New City, which will be new experiences beyond the Wisdom, Understanding, and Knowledge we gain while here on Earth. This will be the Love that goes beyond Knowledge . Pg. 3.

This spirit belittles others by calling attention to their faults; or by barking, it tries to magnify itself. It yelps sharply when in pain to gain attention.



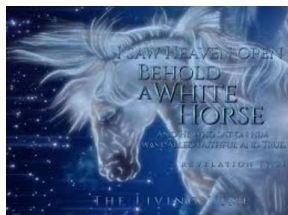

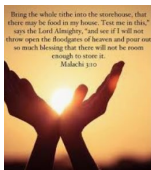
