From the Pen of Reverend B. R. Hicks "Remedy and Relief for You"

Every human mother is a daughter of fallen Eve; hence, every mother is a daughter of sin and death, and the children she bears are conceived in sin.

What are the consequences of being born in sin? It means that every person's soul has been removed from the Fire of God's Presence. This is the reason for everyone's feelings of being lost, cold, and alone until he finds Jesus Christ as his Saviour.

God has provided a **Remedy** for fallen mankind's sinful condition; but, first, each person must recognize and acknowledge that he is a sinner, just as God's Word says. Every person *is* a sinner by *birth* and by *deed*.

I. A Sinner by Right of Birth

King David called upon his soul to behold how he was shapen in iniquity.

Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me (Psalm 51:5).

If a person looks at his corrupt beginning, he must hang his head while his heart agonizes over his condition. Man is shapen in iniquity. In other words, while he is being shapen or formed in his mother's womb, iniquity is woven into the very fiber of his spirit, soul, body, and will.

The Word *iniquity* means perversity. Thus, the very fiber of a person's being is twisted by an evil inclination that causes him always to resist right; always to be obstinate and disobedient; always to be stubbornly contrary; and always to be persistent in his errors and faults.

The sad, mournful fact is that every person is born into the world with a corrupt nature that is wretchedly degenerated from its original purity and innocence. From birth, man has the snares of sin and death in his body, the seeds of sin in his soul, and the stain of sin upon his spirit. His condition is the result of the original and ancient sin that he has inherited from his forefather and mother, Adam-male and Adam-female, both of whom transgressed God's Commandments in the Garden of Eden. The choice they made to be sinners becomes every human being's right of birth or his birthright.

In addition to being born with an inheritance of sin, man is also a sinner by deed.

II. A Sinner by Deed

The evil inclination, which every man inherits at his conception and by which he is shapen, causes him to sin by deed as soon as he is born.

The human heart works wickedness from the time of a person's birth.

The wicked are estranged from the womb: they go astray as soon as they be born, speaking lies. Their poison *is* like the poison of a serpent: *they are* like the deaf adder that stoppeth her ear; (Psalm 58:3,4).

The evil inclination within man grows with each sinful deed, ingraining itself more deeply into his nature through repeated exercise. The following are three examples of the first manifestations of the corruption man receives as his birthright.

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A Message From Our Elders McGriff

"Now these are the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go to possess it: That thou mightest fear the LORD thy God, to keep all his statutes and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged. Hear therefore, O Israel, and observe to do it; that it may be well with thee, and that ye may increase mightily, as the LORD God of thy fathers hath promised thee, in the land that floweth with milk and honey. Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes. And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates." (Deuteronomy 6:1-9)

Tribes of Joseph/Manasseh Cancer June 22—July 22

The nature of the light of the sign of Cancer was imparted to the Old Testament tribe of Manesseh, the son of Joseph. Joseph's double portion of inheritance was divided between Ephraim, who was influenced by the light of Sagittarius, and Manesseh. We already have noted the characteristics of Ephraim. Now let us consider the characteristics of Manasseh. The tribe, along with the tribes of Ephraim and Benjamin, was positioned on the west side of the Old Testament Tabernac-

le where the Headship or Ruling Authority of God was found at the Ark of the Covenant, which was overshadowed with the LORD's *Shekinah* Glory Cloud. This piece of furniture represented the full stature of spiritual growth in Jesus Christ. The twofold characteristic set forth by the tribes of Ephraim and Manasseh (as well as those of the tribe of Benjamin) are needful in order for us to attain full mature Spiritual Stature in Jesus Christ. Let us read Jacob's prophecy to Joseph so that we might understand which portion of the message pertained to Manesseh, whose name means forgetfulness. "Joseph is a fruitful bough, even by a well; whose branches run over the wall: The archers have sorely grieved him, and shot at him, and hated him: But his bow abode in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by the hands of the mighty God of Jacob; (from thence is the shepherd, the stone of Israel:) Even by the God of thy father, who shall help thee; and by the Almighty, who shall bless thee with blessings of heaven above, blessings of the deep that lieth under, blessings of the breast, and of the womb: The blessings of thy father have prevailed above the blessings of my progenitors unto the utmost bound of the everlasting hills: they shall be on the head of Joseph, and on the crown of the head of him that was separate from his brethren (Genesis 49:22-26).

The nature of the light of the sign of Leo was imparted to the Old Testament tribe of Judah, whose name means praise. Naturally speaking, Jesus was a descendant of the tribe of Judah through King David. Let us note the prophecy spoken by Jacob concerning Judah. *Judah, thou art he whom thy brethren shall praise: thy hand shall be in the neck of thine ememies; thy fa*-

ther's children shall bow down before thee. Judah is a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, thou art gone up: he stooped down, he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up? (Genesis 49:8,9). God was praised for Judah's birth; He was praised by him and praised in him; therefore, it is fitting that his brethren should praise him and that he should be victorious and successful in war. Judah represents the roar of praise which shal burst forth out of the Holy City in the ever unfolding ages of Eternity. The praise of the Lion is divided in this prophecy in order to give us greater understanding of the realms of praise.

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Dan – Meaning to judge, those belonging to the tribe of Dan help to maintain balance and equilibrium by weighing the scales of God's justice and judgment through wisdom, courage, and strength that comes from the Word and praying for others (Genesis 49:16-17; Deuteronomy 33:22).

Asher—Meaning happy and blessed, those belonging to the tribe of Asher share the abundance that the LORD has blessed them with and are willing to serve (Genesis 49:20; Deuteronomy 33:24-25).

Naphtali – Meaning to wrestle or fight,


those belonging to the tribe of Naphtali are prevailing ones, who will continue to pray when others give up (Genesis 49:21; Deu-



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Sermon Study #1808 - HOW TO RECKON OURSELVES DEAD UNTO SIN - (SUN PM 10/17/99) This lesson begins with a brief description of the numbers sixteen and thirty-two. There are thirty-two paths of wisdom: sixteen are in the Father and sixteen are in the Son, for the Father is in the Son.

In the Garden, we took on a body of sin. Lucifer works through this body of sin, and we wrestle against principalities, powers, rulers of darkness, and spiritual wickedness in high places.

Man has eight horizontal minds and eight vertical minds. In the Father's realm, there is no past nor future. When the Blesser mind praises God for His headship, the other minds become balanced. Then we can say with Paul, "Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him," because our Recognizer mind or "knowing mind" is in the correct position, also. And we can reckon ourselves dead to sin with our Weaver mind.

However, when the Chooser mind in the body assumes an upright, stolen position, all the other minds assume wrong positions. In the upright position, the Chooser mind, joining with the Decider mind in the will, causes a person to become a reprobate. The Unifier mind, moving into a ruling position, becomes the "Old Fool" in unity with the body of sin.

Did you learn anything this morning about God's Circle of Management? That is an awesome Principle. You have to understand that. When you come to the house of God, God puts a pebble in your soul. Then, if you do not let it hit and let the waves begin to turn in your own life, you hinder other people from getting the blessing because when a wave hits here, then it hits another group, hits another group, hits another group, hits another group, until everybody who wants to be hit is hit.

Many times we come into church, and we are not on fire. This does not mean that we have left God or anything like that. Sometimes we are just beat up. We have worked hard, and we have poured out our energy. A lot of times I come in here, and just wait on the LORD. Sometimes He gives me my own pebble, but sometimes He does it through somebody else. Then, when the waves start moving in me, that kicks them in somebody else; and that kicks them in somebody else; and that kicks them in somebody else. It is just too awesome to go on for God and be obedient. And when you sit there like wood, hay, and stubble, you hinder what God wanted to do through you. You do not have to be in the pulpit to minister. Sometimes you see somebody dancing, and their pebble and their motion set you in motion. This is why we should not forsake the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is. Do you know why? It is because God wants us to see how dependent we are on one another for our waves of blessing. It is so wonderful to serve the LORD, so very wonderful!

Let us go to Proverbs, the sixteenth chapter, and verse thirty-two. There are some people that get into numbers, and they do not even begin to understand the true significance of numbers. I ran into a group in Texas, when I was first down there preaching the Message, and it was a fetish, a fad, or something with them; they counted everything. Suppose you could count everything. You do not know the mysteries of numbers until you know about Jesus and the Father . Now, the number sixteen is what? [The Father] Twice sixteen is what? [Thirty-two] You cannot forget this verse here. Chapter sixteen, verse thirty-two. And there are thirty-two paths of wisdom. The Son has the Father in Him, so He has sixteen paths. And the Father is Who He is, and He has sixteen paths.

Adder — Spiritual Pride (Genesis 49:17).


Alligator — Spirit of Fraud and Robbery (Levitucus 11:10).

Spiritual Meanings of Numbers in God's Word: The number seven is the number of Completion. 1. God rested on the seventh day (Genesis 2:2). 2. Enoch was the seventh son from Adam (Jude 1:14). 3. Noah experienced seven days of Grace after entering the Ark (Genesis 7:1-4). 4. Jacob served seven years for Rachel (Genesis 29:20). 5. Joseph in Egypt experienced seven years of famin and seven years of plenty (Genesis 41:29,30). 6. Joshua used seven trumpets; marches for seven days around the city of Jericho; and

marched seven times around the city on the last day (Joshua 6:4). 7. The Candle stick in the Tabernacle had seven branches (Exodus 37:17.18). 8. Solomon built the Temple in seven years and kept the feast for seven days (1 Kings 6:38). 9. Naaman washed his leprous body seven times in the River Jordan and arose with a cleansed body (II Kings 5:14).

Spiritual Meanings of Colors—The Rainbow: The rainbow contains all the colors in the spectrum. A rainbow is formed in the sky by the refraction, refection, and dispersion of the sun's rays in falling rain or mist. The word rainbow means to reflect, to throw back light, heat or sound; a mirror; to disperse, to break up and to scatter abroad; to scatter rays of light abroad. The following diagram forms a seal of Truth about the colors in the rainbow. A rainbow is a semicircle of seven colors that are produced by the sun's rays being reflected in drops of falling water, such as rain dropping from a cloud or a mist rising from the sea or land. The rainbow appears in the greatest brilliancy when the spectator, the shining sun, is on one side of the sky, and a rain cloud is on the other side. In the natural realm, the rainbow is a sign that proclaims peace between God and man. In the spiritual realm, the rainbow proclaims the peace of the LORD's Eternal Covenant of Mercy and Grace.
