As we look more closely at Israel's Thanksgiving celebration and at the other lessons in this booklet, we will learn more about the kind of gratitude we need to have springing up in our heart and flowing out of our mouth to God. We live in a day of gross ingratitude, but we do not have to let ourself become like the world. Once we understand how far short we are falling, we can repent and let Jesus Christ fill our heart with the same overflowing gratitude that He has for His Heavenly Father. May God bless the words of this book to your heart and life. — The Author

Chapter One — The First Thanksgiving — The Book of Leviticus records the account of the first Thanksgiving Festival. This feast, known as the Feast of Tabernacles, was attended by Israel, the LORD's natural Bride. Just as our own Thanksgiving, the Feast of Tabernacles was celebrated at the close of the harvest season in Canaan's Land.

Chapter Two — Thanksgiving for God's Headship — "In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (*I Thessalonians 5:18*). It is difficult for us fully to obey this portion of God's Word if our faith is not deeply rooted and grounded in the Good, Righteous, and Just Nature of God's Headship. If we are convinced of the Holiness of God's Headship, it is easy to be thankful and grateful for every facet of it in our life.

Chapter Three — True Grace — True Grace is manifested in the form of true gratitude. The word *grace* means graciousness, objective beauty, favour, pleasant, precious, to bend or stoop in kindness to an inferior, to beseech, to have mercy or pity upon; it also means gratefulness and gratitude.

Chapter Four — The Power of a Grateful Mouth — Man's mouth is a powerful instrument that can be used either for good or for evil. God created man's mouth to praise and thank Him and to make His Truth known. Unfortunately, man often fills his mouth with cursing and deceit.

Closing Paragraphs — page 58.

We have been granted the privilege to have life in this present world. We can make it pleasant and enjoyable, or we can make it miserable and wretched, depending on whether we have gratitude or ingratitude for all things. If we choose to let Jesus circumcise our heart of ingratitude, He will also transform our mouth by making it like unto His own gracious Mouth. We, too, can have the same powerful Streams of Gratitude flowing out of our mouth. Words out of a grateful mouth will prophesy and show God's provided Way of Redemption. Grateful words also have power to slay the wicked, and they have power to command Life out of Death.

May we seek God for the removal of ingratitude from our heart and mouth so that our heart and mouth may be filled with the Glorious Gratitude of the LORD Jesus Christ.

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
Sermon Study # 2651 — SCALES OF THANKSGIVING — 3RD MESSAGE — (SUN PM 11/25/2007)

This message continues discussing the three times Christ expressed gratitude to His Heavenly Father from His *lover* heart. On the right side of the scales, He gave *yaw-daw* thanks to His Father that He had hidden the Light of His Salvation Life from those who were wise and prudent in their own eyes.

On the left side of the scales, He gave *baw-rak* thanks for His Body and His Blood — His Life that was on that broken Bread and in that Cup. His Body was broken into twelve parts, pictured by the broken pieces of that Bread that He shared with His Disciples. He gave the Disciples an opportunity to help swallow up that Old Covenant. They had the opportunity to drink of the New Covenant that would get inside of them and swallow up, inside of them, the Old Covenant. Look how far the LORD took them in oneness and unity with His unified experience with the Father and the Holy Ghost, on one side. Yet, on the other side, these people were total strangers to what was going on that night.

And in the middle of the scales, He sang a hymn of haw-lal praise (Matthew 26:30). Jesus jumped and leaped and danced for joy because He knew He was going to the Garden, and He could not wait to go into the next level of suffering in order to do His Father's Will. We are strangers — so often, in certain portions and in great portions — to the long-suffering Nature of the Son of God. But He was not a Stranger to suffering. When Jesus went to the Garden of Gethsemane, He took Peter, James, and John with Him, and He told them to stay awake and pray lest they enter into temptation (Luke 21:40). If the Disciples had stayed awake and prayed with Him, they would not have forsaken Him at the Cross. Then Luke 21:41-46 tells what Jesus experienced as He was praying in agony, in travail. Jesus was drinking the cup of death there in the Garden, and He said, "[F]ather, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done." He was making a demonstration of His total surrender to His Father, saying, "I love You, only You. Not the ministry, not the Plan, not the Purpose even." When Jesus prayed, He sweat great drops of Blood, and the Sea of Water and Blood was formed in the Garden. The Sea of Forgetfulness and Remembrance is comprised of the Blood and Water of Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 5:5-7 was also discussed in this message in relation to the cry that Jesus made in the Garden. Pg. 1.

Save now, I beseech thee, O Lord; O Lord, I beseech thee, send now prosperity. Blessed be he that cometh in the name of the Lord: we have blessed you out of the house of the Lord. God is the Lord, which hath shewed us light: bind the sacrifice with cords, even unto the horns of the altar. Thou art my God, and I will praise thee: thou art my God, I will exalt thee. Chapter Five — Scorpio And The Tribe Of Gad — October 23 — November 21 — Diamond Stone



The sign of Scorpio is the third prophetic light in the sky. The nature of this sign is seen in the Old Testament tribe of Gad. God's blessings of power granted to Scorpio is reflected in the diamond stone. **I. Description of the Sign** — The constellation of Scorpio can be seen in God's Prophetic Calendar between Libra and Sagittarius. Bearing the similitude of a scorpion or serpent, this southern constellation symbolizes death and deceit.



When man fell from God's Scales of Justice (the point of equilibrium) to degradation and death by the Serpent, he entered into the painful experience of being bitten continually by the Serpent. II. The Sign's Relationship to God's Prophetic Calendar The sign of Scorpio speaks prophetically not only of man's continual harassment from the Serpent's bite but also of the time that the Serpent, fallen Lucifer, would bite the Heel of the Man Jesus, Who was our Substitute at Calvary's Cross. If man had perceived the significance of this sign, he would not have been surprised that the Holy, Powerful Heel of Jesus refused the Serpent's sinful poison and that Jesus, in turn, placed His nail-torn Heel upon the Serpent's head of deceitful wisdom, bringing a death to it. III. The Archetypal Man — The sign of Scorpio signifies the generative organs of the grand man in the skies. It represents the sexual or procreative power and system of humanity. Since it is an emblem of reproductive life, the people born under the sign of Scorpio are very fruitful in seminal fluids because this sign causes a creative increase of desire. IV. The Tribe and Stone of Virgo — The nature of the light of the sign of Scorpio was imparted to the Old Testament tribe of Gad, which was identified with the diamond stone. Let us direct our attention to the prophecies spoken to Gad by his father Jacob. V. Description of Virgo People — People born under this sign are meditative, which is a valuable asset. No wonder God desires to give them the mysteries of His Word. They excel in procreative power not only physically but also mentally. They have uncanny wisdom and insight into people and situations. Because of their deep-seated procreative inheritance, they are deeply emotional, affectionate, sympathetic, and understanding. Intellectually, Scorpio people are full of procreative ideas. They have an inexhaustible resource for suggestions, plans, inventions, concepts, and the like. VI. Control of Light — When under the control of the Serpent, Scorpio people can be very secretive, even to the point of alienating themselves from friends and relatives. When the Serpent controls them, they become excessive in their sexual desires. They also can become very angry, obstinate, and headstrong. There is no fury like that of a Scorpio person under the control of the Serpent. They become cynical and selfish. However, if Scorpio people allow the light of procreation to shine down upon them and influence them to come under the Headship of God, they become potential vessels for the depths and heights of God.

Chapter Six — Sagittarius And The Tribe Of Joseph-Ephraim — November 22 — December 21 — Ligure Stone



The sign of Sagittarius is the fourth prophetic light in the sky. The nature of this sign is seen in the OLD Testament tribe of Ephraim, who was the son of Joseph. Although Reuben was Jacob's legal first born, born to his despised wife Leah, the birthright with its double portion of inheritance did not pass to him because of his act of adultery with his father's concubine. **I. Description of the Sign** — The constellation of Sagittarius appears in God's Prophetic Calendar in the sky between Scorpio and Capricorn. This southern constellation is depicted as a centaur (half man and half horse) with the bow and arrow drawn to its head ready for shooting. Thus, we see in the sign of

Sagittarius the appearance of a warrior. II. The Sign's Relationship to God's Prophetic Calendar — Sagittarius prophesies of the dispensation of God's Moral Law, given to Moses on Mount Sinai. Moses descended from the smoking mountain as the archer with the arrows of God's Word. In this sign God foretold the time that He would send forth His Word to penetrate the hearts of mankind and reveal the enemies of sin which are hidden in every human heart. III. The Archetypal Man III. The Archetypal Man — The sign of Sagittarius signifies the thighs of the grand universal man in the sky. It represents the muscular foundation or seat of locomotion of humanity. It is the emblem of stability; it also represents authority, power, and wisdom. IV. The Tribe and Stone of Libra — The nature of the light of the sign of Sagittarius was imparted to the Old Testament tribe of Ephraim, son of Joseph, whose bow abode in strength and whose arms of his hands were made strong by the mighty God of Jacob. We see in Joseph, Egyptian ruler and lawgiver, the powerful arrows of authority which were passed on to Ephraim. During Israel's wilderness journey to Canaan's Land, Ephraim encamped on the west side of the Tabernacle in the Head-realm position by the Ark of God which contained the arrows of God's Law or Word. The tribe of Ephraim was identified with the ligure stone. Let us consider Jacob's blessings to Joseph, for they naturally would include Joseph's son Ephraim. V. Description of Libra People — Because the merciful influence through God's Head-realm Prophetic Word and Glory Light is visited upon the Sagittarians, they are born a very compassionate people. This characteristic is manifested in their tender concern for the needs of the poor, the orphans, the widows, and the sick, for instance. These people are born with a capacity to send forth pleasant words, like arrows, to those who are suffering in heart and mind. VI. Control of Light — A natural arrow is most happy when it can leave the quiver and go to its target. In like manner, Sagittarians are like arrows, for they delight in finding release from the bow, as it were, and are allowed to go their own independent way. Independence is a good quality when it is under the control of the Will of God, but it can be a destructive force when it is under human or Satanic control. VII. Sharing of Light — The light and sweet influences of Sagittarius vibrate throughout the whole world and warm each heart and soul in the natural realm; likewise, this is true in the spiritual realm. When we receive Jesus Christ, the true Warrior, and are quickened by His arrows of Truth, our tongue will become a flaming arrow to show forth the Light and Love of Jesus Christ to a dying World.

PRAYER TRIBES



Issachar — Meaning burden bearer, those belonging to the tribe of Issachar will help bear the burdens of others (*Genesis* 49:14-15).



Zebulun — Meaning exalted, those belonging to the tribe of Zebulun will pray for people experiencing trouble in their homes (*Genesis 49:13*; *Deuteronomy 33:18*).



Judah — Meaning praised, the prayerful praise of those who belong to the tribe of Judah breaks and tears down walls and opposition (*Genesis 49: 10*; *Deuteronomy 33:7*).



Simeon — Meaning to hear, those belonging to the tribe of Simeon are to pray for others to hear and act in obedience to the LORD (*Genesis 49:5-7*).



Reuben — Meaning "behold ye a son," as the firstborn those belonging to the tribe of Rueben will fight against fornication and will fight for divorce settlements (*Genesis* 49:3-4; *Deuteronomy* 33:6).



Dan — Meaning to judge, those belonging to the tribe of Dan help to maintain balance and equilibrium by weighing the scales of God's justice and judgment through wisdom, courage, and strength that comes from the Word and praying for others (*Genesis 49:16-17*; *Deuteronomy 33:22*).



Asher — Meaning happy and blessed, those belonging to the tribe of Asher share the abundance that the LORD has blessed them with and are willing to serve (*Genesis 49:20*; *Deuteronomy 33:24-25*).



Naphtali — Meaning to wrestle or fight, those belonging to the tribe of Naphtali are prevailing ones, who will continue to pray when others give up (*Genesis 49:21*; *Deuteronomy 33:23*).



Benjamin—Meaning son of the right hand, those belonging to the tribe of Benjamin display the twofold nature of the LORD—humility and exaltation—as they pray for Christ's second coming (*Genesis 49: 27*; *Deuteronomy 33:12*).

Joseph — Ephraim — Meaning fruitfulness, those belonging to the tribe of Ephraim depict blessing and fruitfulness that God desires to give in the natural and the spiritual, as they recognize and care for the concerns of those in need (Genesis 49:22-25; Deuteronomy . 33-13-17).



Joseph — **Manasseh** — Meaning to forget, those belonging to the tribe of Manasseh pray for others to forgive and forget through humility (*Genesis 49:22-26*;



Gad — Meaning troop, those belonging to the tribe of Gad pray for the final victory over the enemy, as the tribes work with Christ to overcome (*Genesis* 49:19; *Deuteronomy* 33:20).





Levi — Meaning to be joined to, those belonging to the tribe of Levi join in prayer for those who have a hard time being faithful to what God is doing in all the tribes (*Genesis 49:5-7*; *Deuteronomy 33:8-11*).


