From the Pen of Reverend B. R. Hicks "The LORD's Prayer And The Ten Commandments"



Before Jesus told His Disciples in what manner to pray, He instructed them in how to pray. Knowing how to pray is so important because, in our ignorance, we often pray for things to our own destruction. A man once said that he was glad he had walked with the LORD long enough to find out how good God was not to have answered all of the prayers he had prayed as a young Christian. He had discovered that if God withholds something from us for which we have been praying, it is because He has something better to give us. When we pray, we are sometimes like little children who do not realize that what they want can harm them. We want God to give us guns and knives, so to speak, and all kind of things that could destroy us, yet we would not treat our children in such a way. We would not want them to play with instruments of destruction because, as parents, we would know that they surely would maim themselves. Knowing how to pray makes our praying a beautiful experience. Even before we start to pray, all of us battle a force that wants to keep us from communing with the LORD. This contrary force is the enmity of our carnal mind that does not want us to seek God in prayer. Deep down in our spirit, we feel a reluctance to spend time in prayer. Almost continuously, regardless of how long we have walked on with God or have known the LORD Jesus Christ as our personal Saviour, we find an enmity, a reluctance to spend our time praying and seeking God. The Apostle Paul said that he found the Law working in his mind, and at the same time, his mind was at enmity with God. God's Mind works in our bodies all the time. If this were not so, we would not be able to digest our food, for instance. Yet without our conscious comprehension, God's Mind in us keeps a magnificent program working within our physical bodies that maintains our life and our well-being. So we have a Godgiven body-mind, as it were, to work for us; we also have a soul-mind that helps us to study and comprehend knowledge. Another God-given mind works in our spirit. Our spirit-mind is the one we have to overcome in order to persevere in prayer because our carnal nature, our old heart, is always against our using our energy to serve God. In our threefold being of body, soul, and spirit, the senses of our spirit are faith, prayer, hope, reverence, and worship. These five senses of our spirit are at enmity with God until we allow Jesus Christ to change them back to the purpose God had for them when He created us. If we realize that we constantly struggle against our carnal nature, then we will not feel that we are going through something especially destructive or some special type of animosity or some unique struggle and battle in order to seek God in our prayer closet. This is simply the normal condition of everyone's carnal spirit because it is from our old heart that we have inherited from Adam-male and Adam-female who chose to be independent from God, and so they accepted the Serpent's Will instead of God's Will. We must choose to fight against our inborn carnal nature. we must choose to overcome the enmity that is in the mind of our spirit. This is to our benefit because, when we do, we feel better. Everyone of us has had the experience of pressing on through our reluctance to pray, of persevering over our carnal mind and going on to pray and seek God and, then, feeling so much better when we have done so. Afterward, we rejoiced and were so happy that we had battled against the enmity in our spirit and had entered into the place of prayer, where we found refreshment and peace for our souls. Communing with God in prayer is such a beautiful experience. Prayer is like two buckets on a pulley that draws up water from a well—when one bucket goes down, the other bucket comes up. Thus, while our prayers are ascending to God in one bucket, so to speak, God is letting down His answers in the other bucket.

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The Asking Prayer Of The LORD Jesus Christ And The Holy Ghost Seal Of Complete Spiritual Prayer In Intercession And Travail That Leads Us Upward In the Begotten Stature of the Son, Jesus Christ, And The Unbegotten Stature Of The Father — Preface — The reason for prayer is to express our praise, worship, and thanksgiving to God for His Love and His wonderful Gift of the Life of His Son and the Light of His Word. Prayer is for the confession of our offenses against God, the Holy Ghost, and His Only Begotten Son. Our offenses against God and the creature consist of four major classes: iniquities, transgressions, sins, and trespasses. Our offenses are against the Holy Name of the LORD, which is spelled with the Hebrew letters, yod, hay, vaw, hay. Each letter of His Name relates to His four main attributes. The yod relates to His Wisdom; the first hay to His Understanding; the vaw to His Knowledge; and the second hay to His Prudence. Iniquity, our first offense, is against the *yod* or Wisdom of the LORD's Name. The Hebrew word for iniquity is aw-vone, which means turning from the Light of Truth to take Leviathan's perverse and evil way. Iniquity pulls the soul to turn from the LORD's Light of the Wisdom of His Holy Name. Transgressions, our second offense, is against the first hay or Understanding of the LORD's Name. The Hebrew word for transgressions is *peh-shah*, which means to revolt, to rebel, to break away from just authority, to apostatize, to quarrel, to offend. Man's offense of transgressions causes the soul to turn from the LORD's governmental Understanding. Sin, our third offense, is against the *vaw* or Knowledge of the LORD's Holy Name. The Hebrew word for sin is *khaw-taw*, which means to miss, to sin, to forfeit, to offend grievously, to be accounted guilty, sinner, offender. It is the offense (khaw-taw), sin, that causes the soul to offend the Knowledge of the LORD's Holy Name by leaving and going away from the Divine Source of Fire. God's eternal Existence is the Divine Source of Fire and Life. Sin must be confessed and be repented of, both by the unsaved sinner and by God's people. The following Scriptures confirm this Moral Principle of Truth that both God's people and unsaved sinners must confess their sins. If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land (II Chronicles 7:14). If we deceive ourselves about our sinful attitudes, faults, and failures, we will be unable to confess, admit, and acknowledge them and our guilt, so we will be unable to receive forgiveness. We cannot deny our faults and excuse our failures and still hope to feel the purity and cleanness of Jesus' precious Blood and the Fire and Freedom of the Holy Spirit. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us (I John 1:8-10). The more we see our sinful faults, failures, and feelings, the greater our gratitude and appreciation will be for the precious Blood of Jesus that can cleanse and redeem us from all sin. A true, living walk with Jesus Christ consists of: continual repentance for our sinful wrongs; • perpetual humiliation of our pride of revelation, our pride of redemption, and our pride of satisfaction; • ceaseless mortification of our flesh; • constant faithfulness in God's Word and Prayer; • habitual gratitude for the privilege of being a servant for Christ Jesus; • everlasting Love for our Saviour, Bridegroom, Faithful Steward, and Melchesidec High Priest, the LORD Jesus Christ. Trespasses, our fourth offense, is against the second hay of the LORD's Holy Name. The Hebrew root word for trespass is aw-sham, which means to be guilty, to punish, to perish, to make desolate, to destroy, to offend. Trespasses pull the soul away from the Prudence of the LORD' Holy Name.



Chapter Seven — Capricorn And The Tribe Of Naphtali — December 22 — January 21 — Jasper Stone



The sign of Capricorn is the fifth prophetic light in the sky. The nature of this sign is seen in the Old Testament tribe of Naphtali. The blessing of power granted to Capricorn is reflected in the jasper stone. *I. Description of the Sign* — The cluster of stars of Capricorn appear in God's Prophetic Calendar in the sky between Sagittarius and Aquarius. This southern constellation suggests the form of a goat. Capricorn, the goat, belongs to the winter season, for it is entered by the sun at the winter solstice, about December 22nd. *II. The Sign's Relationship to God's Prophetic Calen-*



dar — When the sun enters this sign at the winter solstice, it is a prophetic picture of Jesus being born in the stable and laid in the manger of the goat in order to conquer the cold winter of sin and save mankind. Jesus Christ came in mankind's spiritual winter season of death. While the cold grip of death kept men bound in their trespasses and sin, Jesus Christ came for the express purpose of becoming a Scapegoat to carry away the sins of all repentant sinners. III. The Archetypal Man — The sign of Capricorn signifies the knees of the stature of the great man of the skies. It represents the pliable and movable parts of the body, the joints. IV. The Tribe and Stone of Capricorn — The nature of the light of the sign of Capricorn was imparted to the Old Testament tribe of Naphtali, which was associated with the jasper stone. Let us go, then, to the prophecy of Jacob concerning the tribe of Naphtali. V. Description of Capricorn People — People born under the sign of Capricorn with its sweet influences of God's Prophetic, Creative Word and Light are strong leaders because they carry the strength of the goat. When a shepherd needs help in leading his sheep, he often puts a goat out in front as a leader of the flock. Sheep have no sense without a leader. They require strong leadership, or they will wander off in every direction. VI. Control of Light — The capacity of leadership is a great asset when it is under the Headship of Jesus Christ, but this power is frightening when it is subject to the forces of evil. People who have been under the sign of Capricorn and who have been blessed with the light-giving influences from God's Prophetic Word in the sky can be very destructive when they yield to the headship (authority) of Satan and to their own carnal headship. For their own gain, they will use their ferreting-out quality to take advantage of the weakness of others. When under their own headship, they use their concentrative, meditative powers for selfish gains and interests. Therefore, it is difficult for them to obtain true spirituality. They also are very critical when under the wrong headship. However, when they yield to God's control of their lives and rely on His Power, rather than their own, they become dynamic, expressive, and aggressive up the spiritual scales. They become alert to seize and take advantage of every circumstance to know Jesus Christ better. Under God's Headship and Authority, they are prevailers and overcomers. VII. Sharing of Light — Although we may not have been born when the sign of Capricorn was in preeminence in the sky, we all can share in its light. The impartial light from Capricorn, the Scapegoat, shines throughout all the world. There is no corner of the globe which is not illuminated by its rays of Truth. If we accept the Creative Word that comes through Capricorn, we will be influenced to bend and bow in humble servitude and worship to Jesus Christ, now, while there is time for us to learn to know His Scapegoat Nature by personal growth in Spiritual Stature. When the Resurrected Bridegroom-Hind senses the matrimonial fragrance of humility upon our mature Spiritual Stature, He will come to consummate the union between our heart and His Heart. VIII. Conclusion — We have seen in this chapter that the fifth sign in God's Prophetic Calendar is Capricorn, the Scapegoat. This sign fore-told the time that Jesus would be born in the stable and laid in the manger of the goat in order to conquer sin and save mankind, by carrying man's scarlet and crimson sins behind the Back of God and depositing them in God's Sea of Forgetfulness where they would be changed into snow and into wool.

Zebulun — Meaning exalted, those belonging to the tribe of Zebulun will pray for people experiencing trouble in their homes (*Genesis 49:13*; *Deuteronomy 33:18*).





Asher — Meaning happy and blessed, those belonging to the tribe of Asher share the abundance that the LORD has blessed them with and are willing to serve (*Genesis 49:20*; *Deuteronomy 33:24-25*).




Joseph — **Ephraim** — Meaning fruitfulness, those belonging to the tribe of Ephraim depict blessing and fruitfulness that God desires to give in the natural and the spiritual, as they recognize and care for the concerns of those in need (Genesis 49:22-25; Deuteronomy . 33-13-17).







Naphtali — Meaning to wrestle or fight, those belonging to the tribe of Naphtali are prevailing ones, who will continue to pray when others give up (*Genesis 49:21*; *Deuteronomy 33:23*).







Reuben — Meaning "behold ye a son," as the firstborn those belonging to the tribe of Rueben will fight against fornication and will fight for divorce settlements (**Genesis 49:3-4**; **Deuteronomy 33:6**).

Judah — Meaning praised, the prayerful praise of those who belong to the tribe of Judah breaks and tears down walls and opposition (**Genesis 49: 10**; **Deuteronomy 33:7**).
