**Spiritual Warfare** 

Natural Warfare

**Introduction** — Spiritual warfare and natural warfare are minutely described in God's Word. Natural warfare, as well as slavery and all forms of violence, is the consequence of sin. Warfare is organized cruelty and wholesale murder. A so-called "victorious" natural war is still a national calamity! Ever since Cain warred against his own brother, killing Abel because of his anger toward him, mankind has been organizing angry mobs to slaughter and kill because of greed for gain.

The LORD is a Man of War Who wars against sin and wickedness in natural and spiritual battles. THEN sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea. The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: he is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him. The LORD is a man of war: the LORD is his

name (Exodus 15:1-3). And Miriam the prophetess, the sister of Aaron, took a timbrel in her hand; and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances. And Miriam answered them, Sing ye to the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously; the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea (Exodus 15:20,21). Since the LORD possesses the Almighty Power of Resistance, which He wields against all evil and wickedness, He is invincible. Man's Salvation and the joyous rapture of his Salvation are both a visible and an evident witness of the LORD's Almighty Power of Resistance against sin, Death, Hell, and the grave. The more believers grow spiritually and serve the LORD Jesus Christ, the more aware they become of His sovereign Authority and Control. As a consequence of their increased awareness, they are able to lift His Holy Name higher and higher. The LORD, as a Man of War, fights down every opposing thought and deed that rise against His Master Plan and Purposive Will. Thus, He ultimately will usher in a perfect, happy future. The Apostle James described the natural warfare of the flesh. FROM whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members? Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not (James 4:1,2). Fleshly lust for worldly gain and fleshly lust for worldly pleasures always generate wars and fightings in the natural realm. Thus, natural man is cursed with fightings within and fightings without. Lustful passions generate war between the conscience of the soul and the corruptions of the flesh. The Apostle Peter warred against this natural warfare found in the flesh, the carnal man. Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; (I Peter 2:11). Children of God must abstain and cease from the natural warfare of the flesh; instead, and, in its place, they are to take up spiritual warfare in Christ's Army. THOU therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also. Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ (II Timothy 2:1-3). Believers in Jesus Christ are soldiers in His Army. They must fight under the banner of His Name, for His cause, and against His enemies. The LORD Jesus Christ is the Captain of the LORD's Host (Hebrews 2:10). Christ's soldiers must prove themselves to be good soldiers by practicing unswerving allegiance to Him, their Captain. They must be faithful to His cause. Christian soldiers always must remember that they are more than conquerors through Christ Jesus (Romans 8:37). A good Christian soldier does not entangle himself in worldly affairs. He always must be ready to answer the Captain's call by taking heed to His commands and demands. Christians must sever themselves from all things that would hinder their holy warfare for Christ and His Kingdom. A good soldier always must be willing to fight in Christ's holy war against sin, the flesh, the world, and fallen Lucifer.



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Sermon Study #1742 — VICTORY THROUGH UNITY AND THE NAME OF YEHOVAH — 1ST MESSAGE (INTRODUCTION TO THE ARRANGEMENT OF THE PRAYER SOLDIERS ACCORDING TO THE TWELVE **TRIBES**) — (WED PM 4/21/99) — When the children of Israel left Egypt, there was not one feeble person among the tribes (Psalm 105:36,37). The LORD gave the Cloud and Fire to lead the Israelites through the wilderness (Exodus 13:18-22). All those who walked under the Cloud and Fire were strong. However, some lagged behind, and they were the feeble ones who were attacked by Amalek. God's Word says that the strong are to bear the weak. So, in Rephidim, when Amalek attacked the weak ones of Israel, the strong ones had to go out to fight the enemy. Each of the twelve tribes of Israel had special armour and weapons that God had provided for them on the banks of the Red Sea. The Egyptians went into the sea with their armour and weapons. When God melted the icy walls, the waters covered them. Then, their dead bodies along with their armour and weapons were washed up onto the seashore. Each tribe had its own particular armour and weapons. When Amalek and his people attacked them, the children of Israel had to join together in unity and go out with Joshua to fight against the Amalekites in the valley. The victory was not won, however, with swords alone. While Joshua and the twelve tribes were fighting in the valley, Moses was up on the hill, holding up the rod with the Name of the LORD on it. When Moses' hands became too tired to hold up the rod, the battle went in favour of the Amalekites. Then, Aaron and Hur came and stood beside Moses and supported his arms so that he could hold up the rod with the LORD's Name on it. Thus, the victory came through the unity of the twelve tribes and the Name of the LORD — Yehovah! In days gone by, we have fought the enemy and gained the victory as individuals. But, now, we must enter into a new class of spiritual warfare. There has to be new unity and a new joining with the Name of the LORD, Yehovah. The prayer groups are being arranged now into twelve tribes, just as the twelve tribes of Israel marched under four insignias. The number twelve has to do with the Son's realm; the number four has to do with the four letters of the Father's tetragrammaton Name. From now on, we will win the spiritual battle against the powers of darkness when all twelve tribes war together collectively by using the spiritual weapons the LORD has given us while holding up the LORD's Name. A demonstration was made showing how one person is defeated by the devils who come against him. There is victory, however, when all twelve tribes join together in unity, with each tribe using the weapons God has given and all lifting up the LORD's Name. Pg. 1. — Sermon Study #1743 — VIC-TORY THROUGH UNITY AND THE NAME OF YEHOVAH - 2ND MESSAGE (THE ARRANGEMENT OF THE PRAYER SOLDIERS — ACCORDING TO THE TWELVE TRIBES) — (THU PM 4/22/99) — (Special Meeting for Prayer Soldiers) This meeting was for the new realm of prayer groups that are arranged into twelve tribes, just as the children of Israel were arranged around the Tabernacle according to tribe. We no longer can get the victory individually. We have to join together and collectively war against the forces of darkness. — The eighth chapter of Nehemiah mentions four classes of people: All the people; Levites; Teachers; and Leaders — Ezra and Nehemiah. This message deals with the four points of Truth that tell what the people did: They gathered as one at the water gate on the first day of the seventh month, which was the Feast of Trumpets. They asked attentively for Ezra to bring out the Book of the Law. While Ezra read from the Book, they stood out of respect for the Word. Then, they worshipped the LORD, with their faces to the ground. Pg. 1. — Sermon Study #1744 — VICTORY THROUGH UNITY AND THE NAME OF YEHOVAH— 3RD MESSAGE (PRAYER SOLDIERS; TWELVE TRIBES) — (FRI PM 4/23/99) — The two sides or natures that the prayer groups must have are represented by Ezra and Nehemiah. Ezra was a priest and a prayer warrior. He was soft and tender; he wept over the sins of the people. Nehemiah was a builder, and he was hard and tough on sinners. When Ezra stood on a pulpit made of wood so that the people could see him as he read the Law to them, thirteen men came to stand beside him. Six men stood at Ezra's right hand, and seven men stood at his left hand. This message focuses on the name of the first man at Ezra's right hand. Mattithiah (or Mattithyaw, as the name is pronounced in Hebrew) means gift of JAH. Psalm 68:4 says, "Sing unto God, sing praises to his name: extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name JAH, and rejoice before him." JAH is the Warrior, the vehement One. When we sing unto JAH and lift up His Name in praise, the Warrior God comes on the scene. And it is His breath, the breath of the Father, that is going to blow out, by gift, everything that is in our way! The Blood, Fire, and Water in the Courtyard of the Son's spiritual stature are gifts to us. In order to grow to spiritual maturity, we must choose to pray and to walk in the light of Truth and in the strength of Truth, and we must choose to come under His headship. Then, because the end is like the beginning, when we get to the Father's realm, the Father's cloud blows us along by gift. A demonstration was made to show the Son's magnetic pulling power and the Father's blowing, pushing power. Pg. 1.



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		The Necessity And	
		Blessings Of Work	
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The LORD's first Command to man was for him to work or "dress and keep the Garden." No greater happiness exists than for a person to know that he is free to fulfill this Command. The Truth is that a person never receives recompense for any more than he does, both naturally and spiritually. The only way to merit reward is to work. Excluding the privilege of having the LORD's Presence in one's heart, the greatest asset to one's soul is having the courage and willingness to work. To work long hours and to do hard work, according to God's Purposive Will, is a joyful blessing! Hard work does not cause mental breakdowns, but the worry and resentment of work does. If a person tries to work without Christ's Life-giving energy, he works without living, which is a tedious, boring existence. But the person who works according to God's Purposive Will generates inspiring enthusiasm for more work. If a person wishes to bless

and benefit mankind, he must do so through his Christlike works. Work is the fruit of industrious intelligence. While we may work as though we will live forever, we must constantly live for Christ as though we will die the next moment. We must work ungrudgingly while we gratefully live for Christ's sake. We must not forget that work without Christ's Character of Love, Joy, Peace, and Faith in our hearts will be a dead work. God-given works that are well done determine our worth. To the LORD, work is indeed a necessity and a blessing. The Book of Genesis records the first Command the LORD gave to man, which was for him to dress and keep the Garden of Eden. And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it (Genesis 2:15). The Hebrew word for dress is aw-bad, which means to work, to serve, to will, to enslave, a bondman, bond service, to compel, and to labor. The LORD God transported Adam to His Garden of Delight and Happiness so that Adam could work and guard it. Even though the Garden of Eden was a perfect place, the LORD God gave man the responsibility of dutifully working there in performing activities that were necessary to maintain it, according to His Purposive Will. The LORD's Paradise was not a place of idleness that exempted man from work; rather, it was a place of responsibility that demanded work. God did not create man to be a lazy, slothful creature. The LORD created man and formed him in such a way that he had the intelligence and capacity to work. God placed man on Earth, which is a place that requires work for its keeping. Earth is where God placed man to serve Him according to His Purposive Will. In the Garden of Eden, the LORD gave His Oral Law to Adam to dress and keep the Garden, which was a command to work. On Mount Sinai, the LORD gave His Written Law to Moses, which contained the command for man to work six days. So when the LORD God engraved His Law in stone, He reinforced His Purposive Will that He had spoken in His Oral Law in the Garden of Eden. The LORD God's Written Word said: Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labor, and do all thy work: (Exodus 20:8.9). The LORD's positive Command to rest on the seventh day or the Sabbath Day was founded upon His positive Command that "thou shalt work six days." When we work six days, we carry out God's Purposive Will. The LORD's positive Command says for us to labor six days, which provides a foundation for the rest He promised on the Sabbath Day. One of the greatest assets we can possess is a willing spirit to perform God's Purposive Will by working six days. If we are to be a blessing and a benefit to ourselves and to others, both naturally and spiritually, we must achieve this through working. All growth depends on working. Work is not a curse. Work is a blessing. Work is the first fruit of intelligence. We can, by God's Grace, work gratefully, or we can, because of our own resentment, work grudgingly. The LORD God, by His Mercy and Grace, anoints all work with His Brightness and Beauty, when the work is done in His Purposive Will. The LORD's Command to work is reiterated in the New Testament. And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you; (I Thessalonians 4:11). A calm, quiet, and peaceable spirit generates a happy worker. Christianity does not discourage believers from taking the responsibility to work with their own hands in order to provide for themselves and others. The Apostle Paul, a mighty man of God, was a true example of a person who lived by God's Working Principle. After these things Paul departed from Athens, and came to Corinth; And found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; (because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:) and came unto them. And because he was of the same craft, he abode with them, and wrought: for by their occupation they were tentmakers (Acts 18:1-3). Although the Apostle Paul had been bred to be a scholar, he had also been taught a trade. Professionally, Paul was a tentmaker. He made tents for shepherds and soldiers. Customarily, Jewish parents taught their children a trade, although they trained them in schools of learning and gave them estates. I, personally had a Rabbi for a teacher, at one time, and he said that if a Jewish parent did not teach his son a trade, it was the same as teaching him to be a thief. Parents considered that if a son had a trade in hand, he was a "fenced vineyard". The Apostle Paul was a prime example of this kind of teaching and experience. He was brought up at the feet of a teacher named Gamaliel; yet, in his youth, Paul had learned to make tents. Although, as an Apostle, Paul was entitled to maintenance from the believers, whom he had led to the LORD and also from the churches that he had planted, he worked at tent making in order to earn his daily bread so that he would not be a charge on the believers. This evidenced great humility on Paul's part, which he had learned from the condescension of his Master Teacher, the LORD Jesus Christ, Who Himself was a lowly carpenter. Although Paul had a great spiritual work to do, which was to teach and write the LORD's eternal Truths and Mysteries, he humbled himself and worked with his hands, thus he earned his bread by the sweat of his brow. Jesus came to minister to others, not to be ministered to. Likewise, the Apostle Paul maintained himself with the labor of his own hands so that he might not make the Gospel of Christ a burdensome stone. The Apostle Paul chose to work with Priscilla and Aquila, lowly tentmakers, because they were rich in God's Wisdom and Knowledge. The Apostle Paul testified to the Corinthian believers that he had waived his right to receive honourable maintenance from them because he would rather abase himself than have Christ's Word be burdensome to them. Have I committed an offense in abasing myself that ye might be exalted, because I have preached to you the gospel of God freely? I robbed other churches, taking wages of them, to do you service. And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all things I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and so will I keep myself (II Corinthians 11:9). The Apostle Paul made the Gospel free to the Corinthians so that he might cut off all occasions for offense, lest any accuse him of designs to gain monetarily by making the Gospel a profitable business to enrich himself. Paul was not a mercenary man like so many of Christ's ministers are today. The Apostle Paul strongly rebuked those among the Thessalonians who refused to work (II **Thessalonians 3:6-12**). Some idle believers among the Thessalonians refused to work, so they lived at others' expense, which the LORD does not recognize as acceptable behavior. Paul described the idle, unacceptable members among the Thessalonians:
