Chapter One — An Introduction — To Basic Demonstrations Of The Spirit — God is a demonstrative God, and He has commanded His children to worship Him in a demonstrative manner. The word demonstrations means a showing or pointing out, an indication, manifestation, or exhibition. When God's children repent, they demonstrate their sorrow and grief for their sins through their prayers and tears. When God's children are happy and in holy harmony with Him, they prove it beyond any possibility of doubt or contradiction by their true, strong, and invincible demonstrations of praise and worship to the LORD. When He is enthroned on a person's heart, God breaks the normal, humdrum routine of that person's spiritual life and worship. When God pours forth His Spirit, moving, energizing, vitalizing, and empowering His people by His Spirit, there is a great demonstrative effect. Where God's Spirit is, there is life, and life must be manifested and demonstrated! There is nothing dead, inert, or dormant about life; it speaks for itself. Life makes itself known and heard. Notice, for instance, healthy children's uninhibited expressions of joy when they are at play. Their exuberant, seemingly ceaseless energy proves that they possess life. Or look at the ecstatic

uproar created in the grandstand when a baseball player makes a home run. People leap for joy, yelling and screaming and creating all the noise they can. Emotions spill out in every form. All this is a demonstration of what the crowd feels within. God made man an emotional creature. Man's emotional energy, which God intended to be used to worship and to glorify Him, unfortunately has been repressed in churches and relegated to the secular world. The Apostle Paul knew the meaning and value of demonstrations in his own ministry. And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God (I Corinthians 2:4,5). The Apostle Paul made many invincible demonstrations which proved, beyond any possibility of doubt, the Power of God's Spirit. He preached Christ's Truths in demonstrations and power. Paul allowed God's Spirit to demonstrate His Power through him, as God worked through Paul in external operations, giving signs, wonders, and miracles performed on men's bodies. God's Spirit also demonstrated His Power through His internal influences on the hearts of men to whom Paul preached. Again, Paul said, "For the kingdom of God is not in word, but in power" (I Corinthians 4:20). God's Kingdom is neither set up, propagated, nor established in the hearts of men by plausible words of reasoning and flowery discourses, but by the external and internal Power of the Holy Ghost. In other words, it is not enough to talk about the things of God; we must be willing for the presence of God's Spirit and Power to be demonstrated in and through us if we want our hearts and lives to be changed. God's Power makes itself known and heard. God's Spirit brings life, and life manifests itself. Knowing when something is alive is evident because it moves and influences things around it. In the natural realm, one must be alive in order to recognize and respond to life in another. So also does it take Spiritual Life for one to be able to recognize and appreciate the presence of Spiritual Life as it is being manifested and demonstrated in the lives of God's people. The Psalmist was aware of this Truth. Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O Lord, in the light of thy countenance. In thy name shall they rejoice all the day: and in thy righteousness shall they be exalted (Psalm 89:15,16). Irrefutably, any person who knows the sovereignty, joyful sound, and Power of God's Spirit is a happy person. His progress is steady toward the goal of his spiritual education and moral development because he walks in the Light of God's Countenance. Not everyone knows the joyful sound of Spiritual Life. To know means to understand and ascertain by seeing, recognition, and comprehension. Was it not so even when God Himself spoke out of Heaven to His Son? The people therefore, that stood by, and heard it, said that it thundered: others said, An angel spake to him (John 12:29).

Sermon Study #2388 — PRINCIPLE OF LEAPING AND SKIPPING — 1ST MESSAGE — WHY JOHN THE BAPTIST HAD TO LEAP IN THE WOMB --- (SUN AM 12 /12/2004) -- (Christmas Message) --- In Luke 1:41-44, when John the Baptist was in a dark place, all alone in his mother's womb, he leaped for joy and praised God for the Seed of the Son of God that was in the womb of the Virgin Mary. The only begotten Son of God had a beginning and an end. And the beginning and the end are the same. There was a circle of praise in the beginning, and there will be a circle of praise from all creation in the end. One Seed of Truth is carried by the chariot of Yehovah Yeshua Maw-shee-akh! In the beginning, when he was in the womb, John the Baptist praised God and leaped for joy over this One Seed. Later, after he came out of the womb, when he was in prison, he sent word to Jesus, asking, "[A]rt thou he that should come, or do we look for another?" (Matthew 11:3). In the end, Jesus Christ is going to receive praise from all creation. We can choose to receive Him now and start praising Him. Or we can choose to wait until eternity, when every knee shall bow and every tongue shall confess that He is Lord, to the glory of God the Father (Philippians 2:10,11). And Jesus had patience to wait. It is our choice to receive Him now or later. The Bible says that the mountains also leap and skip. This is a picture of the anointing of praise that the creation has for the presence of the Creator. The message shows how Mount Lebanon and Mount Hermon relate in the spiritual realm to the Son and to the Father and how these mountains pertain to the White Linen garments worn by the Bride of Jesus Christ. Pg. 1. — Sermon Study #2389 — PRINCIPLE OF LEAPING AND SKIP-PING — 2ND MESSAGE — MOUNT HERMON — (WED PM 12/15/2004) — Luke 1:41 tells us that John the Baptist leaped in his mother's womb, and he did this because the Creator, the Living Torah, was present. And when the unbegotten Torah spoke out of heaven and the begotten Torah spoke on Mount Sinai - double Torah - the mountains of Lebanon, Hermon, and Sinai leaped and shook at the presence of their Creator. The natural creation leaped and skipped on this occasion because man did not praise God for this revelation of His Torah-Truth. Deuteronomy 3:9 speaks of Mount Hermon, which is called Shinar; Mount Hermon also is called Shinar in Zechariah 5:5-11. Shinar is where Wickedness will be imprisoned in an ephah. Psalm 114:1-4 speaks of the mountains skipping like little rams. Leviathan pretends to be the Father; Lucifer pretends to be the only begotten Son of God. When Jesus Christ returns with His Bridal Armies to overcome Leviathan and Lucifer, once and for all, every person in the Bride is going to have their own chariot of the LORD's Name, and on the tops of mountains they shall leap (Joel 2:2-11). There is a seal of joy between the Father and the Son. And God commands us to leap for joy. Mount Zion is our "helmet." When King David was bringing the Ark up to Jerusalem, he danced or leaped before the Ark. His wife Michal looked out the window and saw him making this demonstration of joy, and she despised him in her heart (I Chronicles 15:1-3,27-29). And for this, Michal was barren. First Peter 1:2,3 tells us that we were elected according to the foreknowledge of God the Father. We were begotten by Mercy, double Mercy. This message shows the following six Gentile Kingdoms we have to overcome again in the Father's realm. • Babylon, depicting the Autocratic Kingdom of the flesh • Media-Persian, picturing the fleshly Kingdom of Absolutism • Greece, signifying the fleshly Kingdom of Ambition • Rome, picturing the iron-like fleshly Kingdom of Aggression • Assyria, portraying fleshly success • Egypt, representing the limiting power of the flesh. Pg. 1. — Sermon Study #2390 — PRINCIPLE OF LEAPING AND SKIPPING — 3RD MESSAGE — JOY THAT COMES WITH LEAPING — (FRI PM 12/17/2004) — The Seed of Blood that was given to the Virgin Mary was carried by the Father's chariot of His Name. The Melchizedek Priesthood is a feminine Priesthood. Joy, sim-khaw, goes along with skipping and jumping and dancing over the living Presence of the Father. There is double fruitfulness in forgiveness. The following Scriptures that relate to this particular type of joy were discussed: Psalm 4:7,8; 16:9-11; 43:3,4; Proverbs 10:28. Pg. 1. — Sermon Study #2391 — PRINCIPLE OF LEAPING AND SKIPPING — 4TH MESSAGE — PORCH OF SOLOMON'S TEMPLE — (SUN AM 12/19/2004) — The height of the porch of Solomon's Temple was one hundred and twenty cubits (II Chronicles 3:4). The Hebrew word for height comes from a root word that has to do with the helmet on the Christian soldier, the miter on the head of the High Priest (Ephesians 6:17). The number one hundred and twenty is the number of the Melchizedek Priesthood. On the Day of Pentecost, the hundred and twenty disciples who were gathered in the Upper Room were in one accord when they were baptized in the Holy Ghost and Fire (Acts 1:15; 2:1,2). The porch of Solomon's Temple was a larger, more grandiose thing than the Succoth booth. Although the porch was higher in comparison to what was on the inside of the Temple, it was humble. The counterpart of the porch in Second Chronicles 3:4 is found in Acts 3:1-11. A lame man was sitting at the gate called Beautiful when Peter and John came by. When Peter, with John, fastened his eyes on the lame man and said, "[L]ook on us," he was saying, in so many words, "Look at this Name we are carrying here. It is able to make you leap and walk." After the lame man was healed, he continued to cling to the Brotherhood that gave the blessing. We are not to mistreat the Brotherhood. Ananias and Sapphira sold out the Brotherhood, and the Brotherhood soon carried them out feet first. Do not waste time thinking about what others did yesterday or what you did yesterday. That is what Leviathan would like you to do — cry over spilled milk. It is already spilled. Forget it! Thank God that the milk got spilled because it brought you where you are today! Pg. 1. -Sermon Study #2392 — PRINCIPLE OF LEAPING AND SKIPPING — 5TH MESSAGE — PORCH OF SOLOMON'S TEMPLE — (SUN PM 12/19/2004) — The text of this message is found in First Kings, chapter seven. Verses twenty-one and twenty-two reveal that the pillars called Jachin and Boaz were on this porch. Verses fifteen and sixteen reveal the height. The spiritual significance of a vision seen by Rev. Michael Plack was explained. The oil and the fire at the Candlestick that made the light in the Holy Place every day were a picture of the Oil of Wisdom and the Fire of Understanding that ignite the Light of Knowledge in the spiritual realm. We receive Light as a point, and that point soon becomes a wide spectrum of Light. In First Chronicles 29:10.11, David told Solomon that the LORD had chosen him to build an house for the sanctuary. And the pattern that David gave to Solomon for the Temple was the pattern that the LORD had written on his own body. The porch of the Temple was for the treasures of the Brotherhood. That is why God was angry with Hezekiah when he showed the weapons of the treasury to heathen kings. In eternity the pattern will be written on the outside of the Brotherhood so that others can see what we are telling them. The following levels of circles were discussed in this message: I. Treasuries; II. Chambers, lofty or high places; III. Parlours or the innermost part, the enclosure. Pg. 1.— Sermon Study #2393 — PRINCIPLE OF LEAPING AND SKIPPING — 6TH MESSAGE — THE DIFFERENT JOYS OF THE VIRGIN MARY — (TUE PM 12/21/2004) — Luke 1:46,47 reveals that the Virgin Mary's soul magnified the Lord, and her spirit rejoiced in God, her Saviour. The Hebrew word for rejoiced means that her spirit spinned and danced with the Name of Jehovah Yeshua Maw-shee-akh inside of her twirling and spinning. Much more, then, should we, who have the full Stature of the LORD Jesus Christ (Jehovah Yeshua Maw-shee-akh), be spinning and dancing in our spirits. If David's spirit danced under the shadow and type (Psalm 13:5), then certainly we, who have experienced the reality of the fulfillment, should be rejoicing and spinning in our spirit. This message also discussed the following Scriptures: Psalm 21:1; 86:11,12; 89:15,16; Genesis 3:8-12; Psalm 97:1;118:24; and Isaiah 65:17,18. Pg. 1.

True Freedom Of Expression

Worship services at Christ Gospel Churches are exuberant celebrations of God's Love, Light, and Life. They are a time of joy, a time of gratitude, a time of releasing, and a time of transformation. We shout, we dance, we leap, and we speak in tongues. We clap our hands in song and in praise, and we lift our hands in prayer and surrender. We cry and groan in intercession and travail, as the Holy Spirit moves and speaks through us. Sometimes, we tremble and shake, or fall in a trance or pray face down, as a

symbol of total surrender to our LORD. All these demonstrative worship experiences uplift our hearts and cleanse our minds so that we can receive God's Word on a deeper level. Once people open their hearts to these spiritual experiences, they find great inspiration and renewal and, more importantly, a closer walk with Jesus Christ and a greater understanding of His Word. Our worship services follow a principle of true freedom of expression, a principle well established in God's Holy Word. Spiritual Freedom means to be liberated from fleshly control, both from within and from without. It means to have immunity from the specified control and obligations of unknowledgeable people who would prevent believers from performing true worship to the LORD from their spiritual heart. Spiritual liberty implies the absence of hindrance, restraint, and confinement of the LORD's Holy Spirit by one's carnal reasoning. Spiritual expression is the LORD's Spirit squeezing, pressing, and forcing out of our soul the true worshipful praise and thanksgiving that He desires to hear and to receive. The Holy Spirit enables penitent souls to express their thoughts and feelings through a multiplicity of deeds and words in true worship from their lover hearts, that special place of affection within the heart that God made expressly to love and to adore Him. True worship to the LORD is the powerful, spiritual expression that embodies the heart's thoughts and feelings of love in an emotional form. While this is not a complete study, the following examples in God's Word form the basis of why we worship as we do. I. The LORD Commands Us to Lift up Our Hands in Praise and Worship to Him. II. God Commands Us to Clap Our Hands and to Shout in Triumph. III. The LORD Commands Us to Make a Joyful Noise unto His Name. IV. The LORD Commands Us to Praise His Name by Dancing and Running. V. The LORD God's Unbegotten Power Sometimes Causes His People Who Are Diligently Seeking Him to Fall into a Trance. VI. The Purposive Will and Master Plan for Worship Includes Leaping for Joy. VII. The Holy Ghost Makes Prayer Through a Submissive Soul by Groaning, which Is a Demonstration of a Prayerful Heart. VIII. The LORD Commands and Controls Situations of Life in Order to Bring His People to Weeping at His Feet. IX. As the Early Disciples Did, We Are to Praise and to Worship the LORD by Praying in One Accord. X. The Presence and Power of the Holy Ghost Causes the Submissive Saint to Tremble. XI. The Power of the Holy Spirit Causes God's Servants to Fall Prostrate at His Feet, just as the Apostle John Fell Prostrate at Jesus' Feet.

And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will **pour out my spirit** upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: (**Joel 2:28**).
