

Sermon #2780 Four Cleansings of the Temple— I will never forget the time I first saw spiritual Mount Zion. I already had been in Heaven in the Spirit. I had seen the City. And, oh, it is so awesome. I had been in the New City; I had seen it. I had been told a lot of things, but I never had seen Mount Zion. I remember, I was down in Livermore, Kentucky, and I was staying with some of our relatives who lived in the country. We were having an awesome revival. I had awesome revivals. It was in that revival that God carried me to a mountain. Then, He showed me a mountain beyond that that was like a slate, straight up and down. And the LORD said, "I want you to walk there." I looked and saw it just as Abraham had seen the land. But I was not like Abraham. He arose, and he walked. But I said, "LORD, nobody can walk there. There are not even any steps, and I am a human being. I cannot walk there." But the LORD said, "Yes, you shall walk there." So I said, "LORD, I do not know how, but You lead me, and I will walk there." Time went by, and that revival was over. A few months later, I was carried back to that mountain, and I saw holes—steps, chiseled inside the Rock—but the stairway was not projecting out; rather, the stairway was going into the Rock, and the steps were far apart. I looked with amazement, and I said, "LORD, I cannot walk there yet, either, because my legs are not long enough. You have to have really long legs to go from here and here." It was a miraculous climb. The LORD said, "Yes, but if you follow me, I will lengthen your legs, and you shall walk there." I was in California then; I had just moved to California in 1956, and my children and their father had gone to a place called Knotts Berry Farm. They wanted me to go, so I asked the LORD if I should go, and He said, "No." So I said, "You all go on. I will work here." I was writing Precious Gem In the Tabernacle, so I stayed home. The first thing I did was to go to my prayer closet. Although the door was shut, I was taken out of my prayer closet. I suppose I was taken out body and all, and I was taken to the top of the mountain, and here was a blood-red, velvet carpet going up like stairway. I knew it was the Blood of Christ. Jesus was sitting at the top of the stairway with the marriage covenants in His Hand. There were golden banisters of Wisdom on either side of the stairway. I walked up, and there I took my vows to Jesus Christ. I have not backed up, and I will never back up. I am telling you God is wanting to open your eyes this day. He is wanting to heal your spiritual lameness so that you can walk in new realms that you could not walk in before.

Happy Birthday and Anniversary to all of January's Saints!



Symbol: Water (or mandrake plant; Gen. 30:14)

Stone/Color: Turquoise (or emerald)/Greenish-blue

Jacob's Blessing: Jacob called his firstborn "the first sign of my strength, excelling in honor." But Reuben had relations with Bilhah, Rachel's handmaiden, so Jacob rebuked him saying that he is "unstable as water" (Gen. 35:22; 49:3-4 NXV).


